PUKAW: "THE ART OF BECOMING: IN CONVERSATION AND CREATION" WITH MS. JENSEN MORENO

- Derived from the Tagalog word meaning "to awaken", the PUKAW Initiative is BHSA's most distinguished platform for intellectual and artistic exchange, which seeks to ignite passion, inspire excellence, and elevate artistic consciousness. In relation, this Office announces the conduct of lecture-workshop titled "PUKAW: The Art of Becoming: In Conversation and Creation" with Ms. Jensen Moreno on June 19-20, 2025, at Conference Hall, Bataan High School for the Arts.
- The PUKAW initiative aims to provides a rare and immersive encounter with the nation's most esteemed artists, cultural icons, and industry leaders, offering transformative insights and wisdom. The lectures will cover various topics, including:
 - a. Ms. Moreno's artistic journey and experiences in China;
 - b. intersection of cultural heritage and contemporary art; and
 - techniques and anatomy.
- Ms. Jensen Moreno, an award-winning, Beijing-based Filipina artist, is a Filipino artist who has made her mark in the visual art scene. After graduating with a fine arts degree in 2006, she initially taught in Manila and later moved to Vietnam in 2011. There, she discovered her passion for art while working in a garment factory. Her journey took her to various art spaces in Ho Chi Minh, where she held her first solo exhibit. Her artwork, including a portrait of a farm girl and a painting of paella, reflects her upbringing in rural Bataan and her life by the sea.
- Participants in this 2-day activity are the Visual Arts young artists who are required to attend the morning and afternoon sessions, while Media Arts young artists shall participate in the lecture session only. Moreover, this Office encourages all young artists and faculty to participate actively and take full advantage of this enriching experience.
- To ensure smooth implementation, the Student Affairs Division shall be incharge of the registration and attendance sheet and submit the accomplished documents to Mr. Jomar D. Dela Cruz, Administrative Officer II. The Academic Affairs Division are instructed to communicate to the guest artist to ensure the logistics, session hall, materials needed, and accommodation.
