GUIDELINES ON THE OPENING OF CLASSES FOR SY 2025 - 2026

- 1. This Office announces the conduct and launching of the annual PAKSIBOL, titled "Paninindigan sa Adhikain ng Kilusang Sining na Iniaalay sa Bayan para sa Obrang Lumalaya," as we embark on a new school year. This cultural and artistic gathering will take place on the first day of classes, June 16, 2025, at the PSALM Hotel and Convention Center, starting at 8:00 AM.
- 2. The Student Affairs Division shall ensure that all students receive clear and consistent information regarding dormitory arrangements. To avoid any confusion and to maintain clarity, all discussions and announcements related to housing will be communicated through official channels and means. This includes school memorandum and updates on the school's official website.
- 3. The Student Affairs Division, in collaboration with the Academic Division, shall lead the welcoming of new scholars and announcing of the class and program implementations on Monday. As the divisions entrusted with the oversight of students' wellbeing and academic matters, they shall ensure a seamless integration of scholars into the academic environment. Additionally, the Student Affairs Division is scheduled to provide update on the student handbook to the Office of School Director (OSD) for review, on June 16. This review will help refine the resources available to students, ensuring they receive comprehensive guidance throughout their academic journey.
- 4. To fulfill the responsibilities outlined in Republic Act No. 11190, which established the BHSA, the Student Affairs Division is responsible for efficiently managing the welcoming of students arriving over the weekend. This is especially crucial for those residing outside of Bataan or with unique travel arrangements. To fulfill these obligations, the Student Affairs Division must develop a comprehensive reception plan that addresses logistical challenges faced by students and parents. Effective communication channels should be established to coordinate weekend arrivals, ensuring all parties are informed and prepared. Support systems within the school should be created to help students transition smoothly into the school environment, offering necessary guidance and assistance.




