Academic Division, Finance Division, Admin Division and Office of the School Director.

Theme Dish Requirement:

Each team must prepare one complete meal (main dish + side or rice) that:

- Is nutritionally balanced
- Costs no more than P100.00 per serving
- · Uses local, seasonal, or indigenous ingredients
- Can be prepared in 45 minutes or less
- Each team will bring their own cooking materials (Cooker, gas stove, pot, mixing bowls, plating etc.)

Allowed Ingredients:

- Locally available produce
- Whole grains, root crops
- · Lean proteins (e.g., fish, munggo, eggs, tokwa, tofu)
- Fortified or nutrient-rich food products

Judging Criteria:

Taste & Palatability	Flavor, texture, and overall appeal	20

- Must be an **original composition** (melody + lyrics)
- Lyrics should reflect the 2025 theme and emphasize:
 - Food and nutrition as a right
 - Food accessibility and security
 - Healthy eating habits
- Language: Filipino, English, or Taglish
- Duration: 2 mins

Dance Mechanics:

- Choreography should match the jingle
- Dance must be age-appropriate, wholesome, and creative.
- · Props and costumes allowed (optional), but must support the message.

Submission:

- Video Recording of performance July 17, 2025
- Live performance on contest day July 18, 2025
