## IMPLEMENTATION OF ALTERNATIVE DELIVERY MODE (ADM) ON JULY 28-29, 2025

To: Chief Administrative Officers Chief Education Program Specialist All School Office Personnel Young Artists and Parents All Others Concerned

- Due to the impact of recent typhoons and the enhanced Southwest Monsoon (Habagat), BHSA facilities, including the electrical system, and the temporary student dormitory at PSALM acquired damages and is subjected for repairs, this Office announces the Implementation of Alternative Delivery Mode (ADM) on July 28-29, 2025 for all grade levels.
- 2. Upon the agreement during the emergency meeting held on July 26, 2025 (9:00 am) attended by the School Director, Chiefs/Supervisors/Unit Heads of each Functional Divisions, Dorm Managers, and other concerned non-teaching personnel, this Office issue the precautionary and adaptive measures to ensure the safety and well-being of all learners and personnel.
- DepEd Order No. 22, s. 2024 (Implementing Guidelines on the 3. Cancellation or Suspension of Classes and Work in Schools in the Event of Natural Disasters, Power Outages/Interruptions, and Other Calamities), which authorizes school heads to suspend classes and work based on local assessments of safety and accessibility, the following measures shall be implemented:
  - Alternative Delivery Mode (ADM) shall be implemented for all learners on July 28-29, 2025.
  - Face-to-face classes shall resume on July 30, 2025, subject to favorable weather conditions.

A separate memorandum shall be issued for the extension of ADM if condition did not meet.



The damaged ceiling in the conference room caused by persistent water leakage from heavy rainfall.



A ceiling water leak in the admin office triggered an electrical wiring fuse, posing a serious safety hazard.







The entrance to the administrative building was flooded due to continuous water leakage from the ceiling.





















