- In line with the General Plan of Action of the Supreme Secondary Learner Government (SSLG), the Bataan High School for the Arts (BHSA) will conduct a two-part community outreach program titled "PAK-Laum: Series of Art Movements through Exchange and Mentoring." This initiative promotes creative expression, cultural preservation, and leadership development through a collaborative mentorship with the community of Matalangao, Barangay Banawang, Bagac, Bataan.

 - c. Provide two-way mentorship between BHSA scholars and community members;
 - d. Train student leaders to advocate for the role of arts in cultural and social development.

 - A. Art Movement Session 1: Ocular Visit and Community Engagement

Date: August 21, 2025

Purpose: Meet with community leaders and conduct a preliminary assessment to identify participants and needs for the outreach.

B. Art Movement Session 2: Outreach Program

Date: September 27, 2025

Activities: Visual and theater-based workshops, community performances, and cultural exchanges led by selected BHSA students, teachers, and SSLG officers.

- Target Participants are 19 Junior High School students, 4 Senior High School students, 5 Teaching Personnel, 25 Community members, and 3 Community/Barangay Representatives (see Enclosure 1). All participants involved are expected to coordinate with the Program Management Team (PMT) to ensure necessary preparations and documentation are completed.
