1. 2. This activity is part of PAK Initiative's Pintigan sa Sining, a capacity-building initiative designed to immerse students, faculty, and staff in the living tapestry of arts and culture, bridging theory with practice. The objectives of this immersion are as follows

Dorm aides shall assist PSALM students in preparing for the activity, ensuring readiness during rehearsals and providing necessary personal support.

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7. Participation in these activities may entitle eligible personnel to service credits or Compensatory Time Off (CTO), subject to existing DepEd policies and approval by the appropriate authority.
