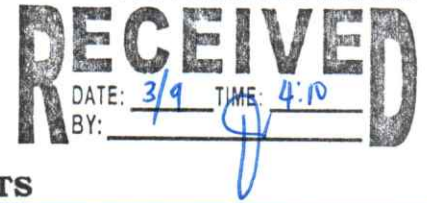

PHILIPPINE BOOK FESTIVAL 2026 "SI OKTU-PUNAS"**

1. This Office announces the participation of Bataan High School for Arts students specifically the Theatre and Media Arts students for their participation in Pintigan sa Sining which includes attendance at a classical show entitled **PHILIPPINE BOOK FESTIVAL 2026 "SI OKTU-PUNAS"** on March 14, 2026, at 5:30pm at **PBF2026 Megatrade Hall, Mandaluyong City**.
2. This activity is part of PAK Initiative's Pintigan sa Sining, a capacity-building initiative designed to immerse students, faculty, and staff in the living tapestry of arts and culture, bridging theory with practice. The objectives of this immersion are as follows
 - a. To enhance artistic and cultural awareness through experiential learning;
 - b. To provide opportunities to participate in national and regional cultural events; and
 - c. To strengthen collaboration between students, educators, and cultural institutions.
3. All expenses related to this activity, including registration, transportation, and meals, shall be charged to school funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
4. The Consent Form shall be released by the Student Affairs Division a week prior to the event.
5. The Student Affairs Division is directed to secure parents' consent, coordinate with partner institutions, facilitate proper documentation, and manage logistical support for participants. Dorm aides shall assist PSALM students in preparing for the activity and providing necessary personal support.
6. This activity aims the students of Bataan High School for the Arts in the Philippine Book Festival 2026, organized by the National Book Development Board, is relevant to the curriculum because it allows students to apply their learning in Arts, Literature, and Humanities through actual performance. The activity supports performance-based assessment, strengthens cultural appreciation, and develops essential skills such as creativity, collaboration, and communication, making it a meaningful extension of classroom instruction.
