**ACADEMIC ROADMAP 2026: FINALIZING THE BHTA ARTIST-SCHOLAR CURRICULUM FRAMEWORK**

1. Relative to the upcoming 2026–2027 school year, this Office announces the conduct of the **Academic Roadmap 2026: Finalizing the BHTA Artist-Scholar Curriculum Framework** on **May 24–25, 2026**, at **Hacienda Gracia, Lubao, Pampanga**.
2. This finalization stage marks the critical transition from developmental validation to institutional readiness. It focuses on consolidating insights from the validation phase to refine interdisciplinary frameworks and perfect the integration of *puso, isip, at diwang Pilipino* across all specialized arts tracks, ensuring a polished, coherent, and actionable curriculum.
3. Specifically, the two-day activity aims to achieve the following objectives:
  - o **Finalize Content & Assessment:** Finalize all curriculum content and assessment tools for Grades 7–12, ensuring seamless vertical and horizontal alignment across all BHTA specializations.
  - o **Incorporate Policy Standards:** Embed culturally responsive approaches within the framework in full compliance with *Sulong EduKalidad* standards and the K–12 mandate.
  - o **Reconcile Stakeholder Feedback:** Reconcile feedback from faculty, DepEd specialists, and cultural partners into a unified, high-standard document.
  - o **Technical Packaging:** Complete the technical packaging of the "*Sining Bilang Buhay*" framework as a policy-compliant roadmap for the 2026–2027 school year.
  - o **Establish Shared Mastery:** Foster shared mastery of the finalized framework among stakeholders to ensure a smooth transition to innovative classroom execution.
